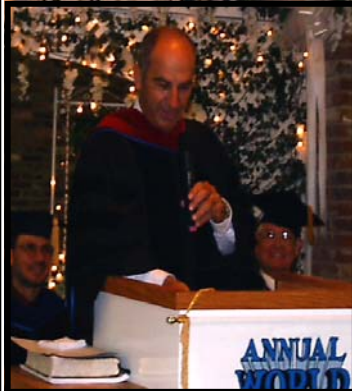

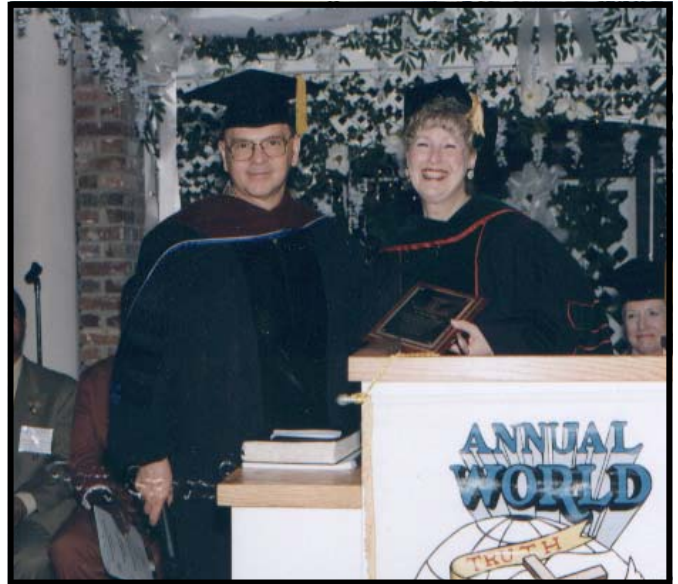

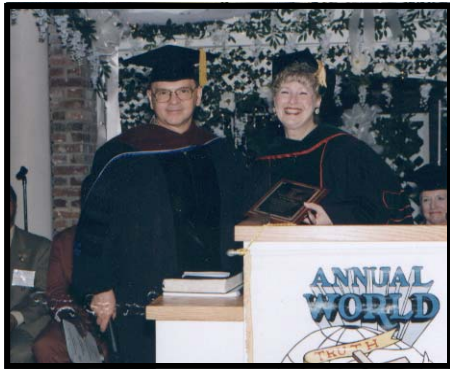


### Dr. Emmanuel M. Edwardson
